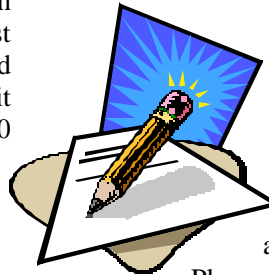

Gary Davidson of 3X Corporation will give an overview of the recent V5R1 announcements for the AS/400.
