Directions:

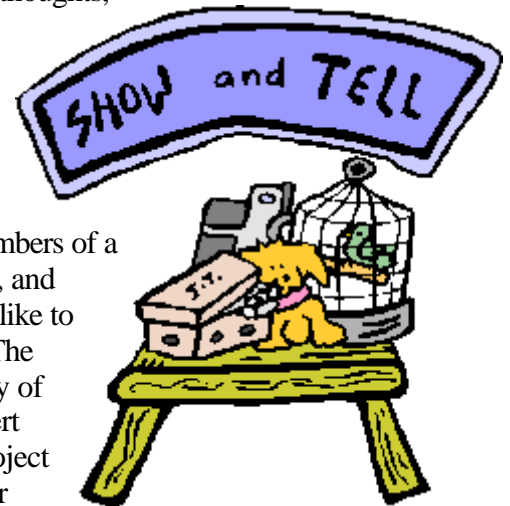

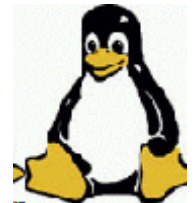
This same format was used for our November meeting and the feedback said the topics were very useful and the session was very productive.
